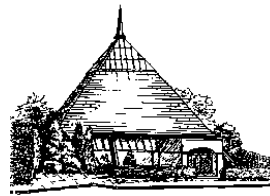
**ACTS 6**

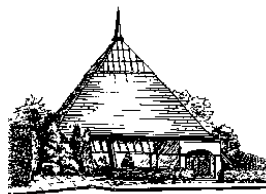

**TRAIDCRAFT UPDATE 2019 – STALLS AT CHURCH**

Due to the uncertainty of the future of Traidcraft we have not restocked our stall since before Christmas as their stocks were low. However, Traidcraft is continuing with a smaller business model, but a reduction in the products offered, especially in the craft range.

Food key product ranges that will be taken forward include: tea, coffee, biscuits, sugar, chocolate (including the new white muscovado chocolate) sweets, honey and spreads, muesli, store cupboard ingredients, household items (hard soap, tissue range and gloves) We will continue to stock products from other companies that complement the Traidcraft grocery range including: Divine, meaningful Chocolate Company, CafeDirect, Zaytoun, Liberation, Fish4ever, calypso, Kilombero Rice and Bio-D. Unfortunately Geobars have gone completely.

With this in mind we would like to have your views as to continuing to have a Traidcraft Fairtrade stall every month after church and if so, which products you would be interested in buying from the stall.
