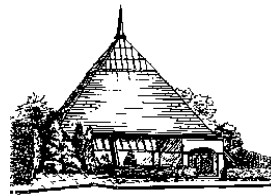
**TOMORROW, MON 15<sup>th</sup> APR, 1.30 for 2.00pm – DRIVERS TALK POLESDEN LACY**
